2m - 147.120 Mhz / +600Khz, PL (146.2), P25 / Echolink 70cm - 443.8 Mhz / +5Mhz, PL (146.2), Fusion / P25 / FM 1.25m - 224.180Mhz / -1.6Mhz, PL (146.2)

Any licensed amateur radio operator may activate an emergency net under the following circumstances; permission is not needed.

- A When traditional communication systems (e.g., landline and cell phone service, Internet service, etc.) have failed in one or more of the following counties (Culpeper, Madison, Orange, and/or Rappahannock).
- B When a natural disaster is imminent or has taken place (e.g., heavy snow, flooding, tornado, derecho, earthquake, hurricane, etc.) in one or more of the following counties (Culpeper, Madison, Orange, and/or Rappahannock).
- C A Disaster Declaration has been issued by the State of Virginia for one or more of the following counties (Culpeper, Madison, Orange, and/or Rappahannock).
- D A National Emergency has been declared by the Federal Government using the Emergency Alert System (EAS) or other means.

## E - For training purposes.

Nets shall run on the following schedule until such time as the net is no longer needed (all times are local) and/or at the discretion of Net Control (e.g., skipping the 2400-hour net, as well as the 0400-hour net, as per local needs and conditions).
